The Sweet Booth was a success last year due to all of your generous donations. We feel this year will be great as well. We decided to narrow the sweets down to the top sellers from last year. We are asking for donations from the list below. In addition to the sweet booth, we will be having a cake walk at the Hospitality Booth. The cake walk will give away either whole cakes of any sort or a whole pan of something like brownies or rice krispie treats. Please read below to see the list of items wanted and a brief explanation.

Pralines

Cakes - any type of cake is appreciated; examples are round cakes, square cakes, bundt cakes, flavored cakes (ex. carrot), or a dozen of cupcakes
